The ribbon cutting in the fall marked a milestone in the Center's journey. The strategic renovations laid a solid foundation that ensures the Center continues to grow and thrive.






THE ACADEMY



Saint Catherine Academy serves young people with disabilities, ages 5 to 22. Classrooms are grouped around individual needs and capabilities. Students are accompanied on their journey toward independence by certified special education teachers and teaching assistants, licensed therapists, caring volunteers, and their peers.





Academic learning is integrated with life skills which are reinforced through community and vocational experiences.





Activities of daily living are practiced regularly to gain independence.

BUILDING EXPANSION...

& RIBBON CUTTING



The Center completed a successful \$5M Building for the Future expansion project that doubled the size of the current facility. The expansion provided the resources to reimagine programming and offer enhanced learning experiences, including authentic vocational training opportunities.



Flexible spaces were created to accommodate a variety of purposes, from quiet meditation to socialization with group activities.

PLAYGROUND

Construction of a fully accessible playground was completed in the spring of 2024. The playground's design prioritizes universal accessibility, ensuring that children and adults of all abilities can participate and play without barriers.

The playground features standard and inclusive equipment for those with ambulatory issues and is sturdy enough for adults.






